All REFERRALS:	Include pt's last PE, progress note for visit that generated referral, current med list, & pertinent labs.	
Partial thickness > 10% total body surface burns of the face, hands feet, genitalia, perineum, or major joints. Third degree burns, electrical burns including lightning injury, chemical burns, inhalation burns, burn injury with preexisting medical disorder that can complicate management, burns with concomitant trauma, burn injury In patients who require special social, emotional, or long term rehabilitative intervention		REFER DIRECTLY TO RIH ER OUTSIDE ER CALL 444-4000 PAGE BURN MD ON CALL
Partial thickness burns<10% total	None	Sterile dressings with Silvadene refer to clinic within 1-2 weeks
