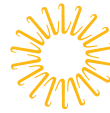

General Hematology Program:

Expert consultation for a wide range of hematologic disorders

Rhode Island Hemostasis and Thrombosis Center:

Multidisciplinary care for hemophilia and other bleeding or clotting disorders

Adolescent Menstrual and Hematologic Disorders Program:

Combined visits with Adolescent Medicine for abnormal menstrual bleeding and complex contraception discussions

Comprehensive Hemoglobinopathy Program:

Holistic, multispecialty care for sickle cell disease and thalassemia

Hematologic Malignancies Program:

Specialized care for hematologic malignancies, including leukemia and lymphoma
