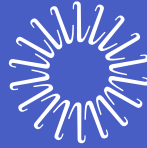

Orthopedics

Orthopedic medicine is the treatment of conditions related to the musculoskeletal system, which includes not only bones but muscles, joints, nerves, tendons, cartilage and ligaments.

Physicians who specialize in orthopedic medicine are called *orthopedists* or *orthopedic surgeons*, although most problems do not require surgery. Orthopedic surgeons specialize in alleviating pain and dysfunction associated with the musculoskeletal system, whether from injury, trauma or other causes.

One of the most common injuries they address is *fractures*, which is the medical term for broken bones. They also frequently treat arthritis, foot and ankle pain, and back pain, among other conditions.
