Standard Summary Paragraph Educational Training

Since October 1, 2001, Lifespan has required that researchers and IRB members read Protecting Study Volunteers in Research (Dunn & Chadwick) and complete the related exam. This process has served as initial certification.

In June, 2005, [the Office of Research Administration](#) contracted with CITI, a Collaborative Institutional (modular) Training Initiative program, for our Human Subjects protection and HIPAA training for all research personnel. Currently this program offers our researchers a basic human subject's protection course as well as a refresher course which we require every three years. Documentation of successful completion is automatically generated and [should](#) be printed directly by the researcher.

Additional and continuing education opportunities for clinical researchers include the Office of Research Administration newsletter that is circulated to > 900 recipients every 6 weeks. In addition to standard institutional research information, the web page contains links to other sites such as CenterWatch, NIH, PRIM&R/ARENA.
