

Lifespan Masking Guidelines August 2021

Setting/Situation	Regardless of Vaccination Status
Clinical Areas	Must be masked at all times.
Hospital Cafeterias and Cafes	<p style="text-align: center;">Must be masked except when actively eating/drinking and must remain six feet apart or behind a physical barrier when eating/drinking.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Staff preparing food must be masked regardless of vaccination status.</p>
Common Areas (e.g., lobby or hallways)	Must be masked at all times.
Staff Breakrooms	Must remain masked, except when eating/drinking. Must remain six feet apart, or behind physical barrier, or alone in the breakroom when eating/drinking.
NON-Clinical Area where employee works alone (e.g., in office)	Can be unmasked. Must put mask on when anyone is in their space and whenever they leave their space.
NON-Clinical Area where employee works at a desk, cubicle, or workstation next to others	Must remain masked AND six feet apart unless separated by a physical barrier (wall, plexiglass, cubicle).
In-Person Meetings*	Must be masked.
*NOTE: Use of virtual meeting technology – e.g., Teams, strongly encouraged	If an employee eats/drinks during a meeting, they should remain six feet apart unless separated by a physical barrier (wall, plexiglass, cubicle).
Shuttles	Must remain masked when riding the shuttle.
