



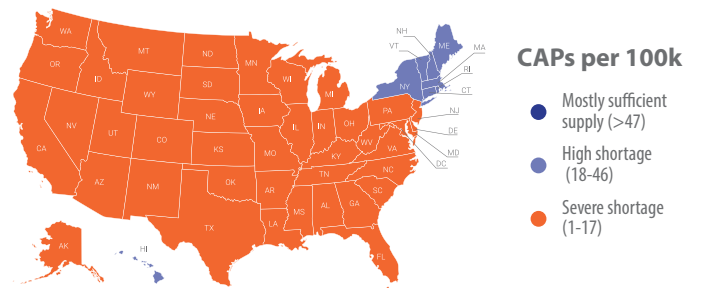
Emma Pendleton Bradley Hospital

 - Outpatient, inpatient, IOP and partial hospitalization programs
 - Support for pediatricians in mental health assessment/treatment
 - As is attested to by more than 350 Bradley alums spread over the U.S.
- Bradley's outstanding results have led to federal (SAMHSA) recognition and high payer satisfaction
 - 100% abstinence of teens with co-occurring disorder while in substance abuse IOP
- Lowest teen suicide rate in the U.S.

Evolution of Need

REACH Solution:

The program expands Bradley Hospital's expertise in caring for the mental health of children and adolescents through education, consultation and telemedicine services using Remote E-Therapy for Children and Adolescents, (REACH). Through REACH, Bradley Hospital's renowned clinical expertise is amplified, working with children's hospitals and other mental health care settings to build innovative solutions, regionally and nationwide.

Programs: A continuum of care with high-quality, **virtual, partial, and intensive outpatient programs**, bridging the care gap between inpatient and outpatient services

Behavioral Health Education: Professional development for staff across disciplines

Consultation: Dedicated Bradley staff to help build or improve services needed for local growth (collaboration with schools)

High Value Care

- Improved quality of life for (young) patients:
 - More children receive care in their own environment
 - Families experience less stress caused by logistical hurdles
- Lower costs of care for society:
 - Diversion from higher levels of more expensive care (inpatient) and easier discharge from inpatient treatment (stepdown)
 - Lower recidivism, fewer high-utilizers, less ED boarding, less dysfunction in adult life
