Stop TIME prior to scheduled test	Medications to <u>STOP</u>
48 Hours	<u>Stop</u> all daily inhaled medications except for Atrovent and Combivent (see below)
24 Hours	Stop these inhaled medications and antihistamines: Atrovent (Ipratropium Bromide), Combivent (Ipratropium & Albuterol) Zyrtec, Allegra, and Claritin type antihistamines
24 Hours	Stop these oral medications: Accolate (Zafirlukast), Zyflo (Zileuton), Singulair (Montelukast)
8 Hours	Stop these inhaled medications: Proventil, Ventolin, Albuterol, Pro-Air, Xopenex (Levalbuterol), Cromolyn
Day of test	No vigorous exercise and No caffeine (including chocolate)

Please continue to take all your other medications as prescribed. If you have any further questions regarding your medications, please ask your physician for clarification.
