**Instructions for Sigmoidoscopy without sedation**

**Purchase from the Pharmacy:** Two (2) Fleet enemas

**Important:** No gum or candy. Nothing by mouth after 12:00 midnight on day before procedure.

**Morning of Sigmoidoscopy:**

Take two (2) Fleet enemas as instructed below:

- \* The first enema is to be taken two (2) hours before arrival.
- \* The second enema is to be taken one (1) hour before arrival.

**Medications:** may be taken with sips of water in the morning of procedure day.

**Diabetic patients:** Please check blood sugar level before your procedure.
